## How Do I Enroll?

There are three ways available to obtain retired membership:

1. **Former Certified Annual Membership** (\$60.00 annually after you retire) Deduct annual dues at a monthly rate of \$5.00 (ERB retirement check)
2. **Former ESP/Classified Annual Membership** (\$36.00 annually after you retire) Deduct annual dues at a monthly rate of \$3.00 (ERB retirement check)
3. **Former Certified Life Membership** (\$500.00, a one-time payment at retirement) \*whatever the fee is when you retire
4. **Former ESP/Classified Life Membership** (\$300.00, a one-time payment at retirement.)
5. **Pre-Retired Certified Life Membership** (\$500.00 a one-time payment while still an active member) \*The advantage of pre-retired is if the membership cost increases, (which it may), you will not need to pay more at retirement. your membership is completely paid.
6. **Pre-Retired Classified Life Membership** (\$300.00 a one-time payment while still an active member) \*The advantage of pre-retired is if the membership cost increases, (which it may), you will not need to pay more at retirement your membership is completely paid.

**Your dues include membership in both the State and National Association.**
